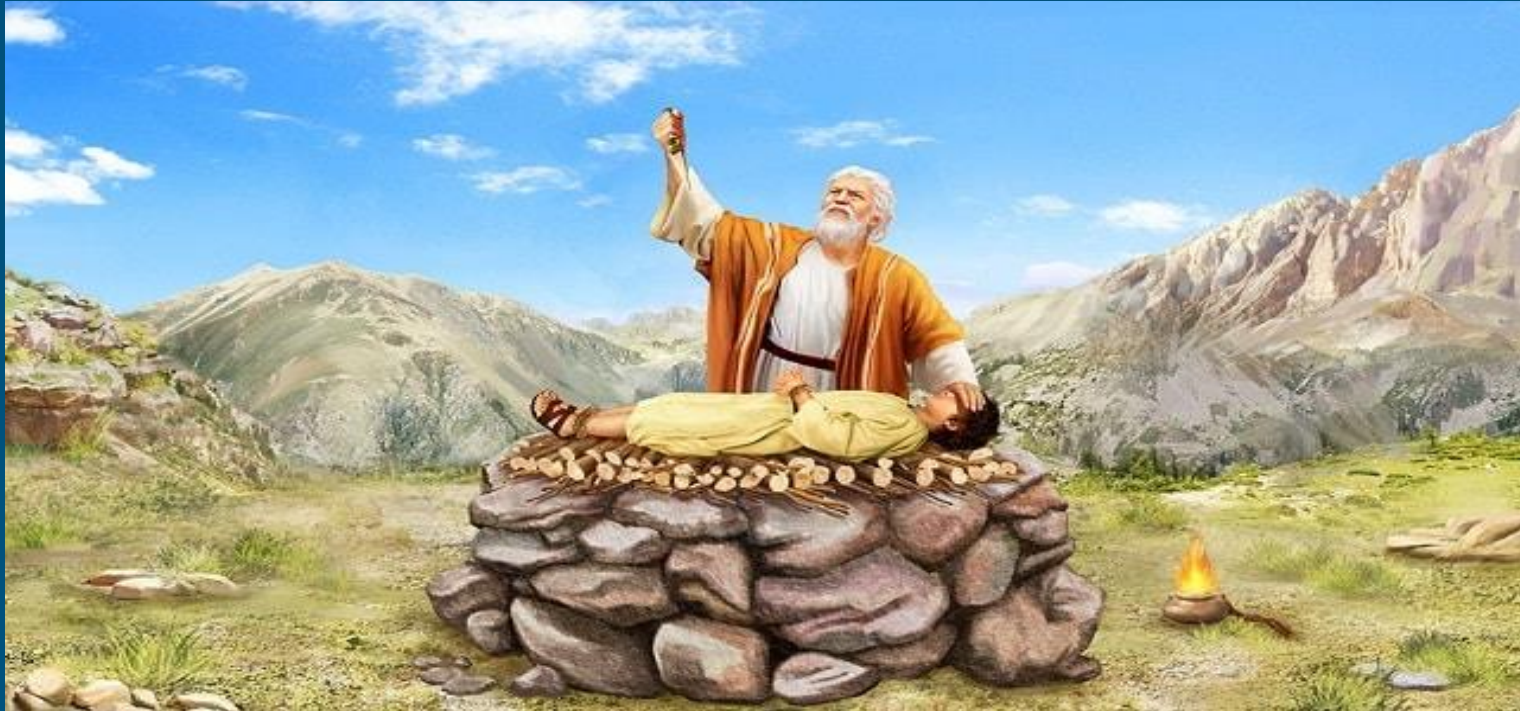
# Part 2 Prophecy About Jesus Christ

And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where *is* the lamb for a burnt offering?” “ And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

God asked Abraham to sacrifice his only child, Isaac .Abraham was so faithful to God that he obeyed God’s unexpected command and went up the hill with Isaac carry wood for the sacrifice.
